Regulations on the Selection of Director for the Institute of Marine Affairs and Resource Management, College of Ocean Science and Resource, National Taiwan Ocean University

Article 1

These regulations are established in accordance with the guidelines for the selection of supervisor for the academic unit of this university.

Article 2

The director of the institute must be at least a full-time associate professor of the Institute, whose term of office shall be 3 years and may be re-elected once.

Article 3

Within six months prior to the expiration of his/her term of office, the current director shall request the dean to organize a new director selection committee.

Article 4

The members of the director selection committee are as follows:

- 1. Chairman Dean of the College
- Members consisting of five to seven members (including at least one-half of the faculty), selected among the Institute's directors, who are all full-time professors or at least part-time associate professors

Article 5

Director candidates shall be selected by full-time faculty members based on the qualifications stated in Article 2; after which, the director selection committee shall recommend to the dean two director candidates for president based on the number of votes.

Article 6

If the director is re-elected after garnering more than $\frac{2}{3}$ consenting votes from attendees belonging to $\frac{2}{3}$ of full-time faculty members, the dean may report the said director's re-election to the president.

Article 7

If there is a decision to remove the director, after reaching more than $\frac{2}{3}$ consenting votes from attendees belonging to $\frac{2}{3}$ of full-time faculty members, the dean may report to the president the said director's dismissal prior to expiration of the term of office.

Article 8

If the current director vacates his/her post during his/her term of office, the president may select an acting director among the institute's qualified full-time faculty members who are at least associate professors. The tenure shall not exceed one year until the new director is appointed.

Within two months of his/her term of office, the acting director shall request the dean to organize a new director selection committee.

Article 9

These regulations shall be enacted and implemented after approval during the institute meeting, college meeting and administrative meeting.
